

Estate Administrators (Registration and Examinations)  
(Amendment) Rules, 2018 (No. 4)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Justice, Legal and Parliamentary Affairs has, in terms of section 66 of the Estate Administrators Act [Chapter 27:20], made the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Estate Administrators (Registration and Examinations) (Amendment) Rules, 2018 (No. 4).

2. Section 13 of the Estate Administrators (Registration and Examinations), Rules, 2004, published in Statutory Instrument 2 of 2004 (hereinafter referred to as the “principal rules”), is repealed and the following is substituted—

*“Annual fee*

13. (1) The practising fee payable by a registered Estate Administrator shall be—

- (a) \$400,00, for initial registration;
- (b) \$270,00, for annual renewal of practising certificate;
- (c) \$120,00, for annual subscription payable by a member.

(2) The annual fee shall be payable as soon as a person is registered as an Estate Administrator and shall thereafter become due and payable on the 1st January in each year.

(3) If a person ceases to be a registered Estate Administrator during any year, no portion of the annual fee shall be refunded to him or her.”

3. The First Schedule of the principal rules is repealed and the following is substituted—
